Annual Recital Information

Our thirteenth annual recital is scheduled for Saturday June 14th and Sunday June 15th, 2008 at PS 58 on Marsh Avenue across the street from the back of Macy's at the Staten Island Mall. The arrangement of classes in five separate shows has been completed and is posted in the studio lobby. If you are uncertain which show your children are assigned, please ask the receptionist for help. We present five shows, three shows on Saturday and two shows on Sunday. Each show will be approximately two and a half hours long with no intermission.

Ticket Sales

Tickets are sold on a first come first serve basis on designated days for your particular show. According to customer feedback most people are happy with our ticket sale system so we will continue to sell the tickets in the same fashion. The sale of tickets for shows 1 and 2 will be held on Sunday April 13th, show 3 on Sunday April 27th and shows 4 and 5 on Sunday May 4th. We will begin selling tickets at 9 am on each of those days. A few weeks before your ticket sale you will be given a line card for your particular show that you must bring with you to the ticket sales. There will only be one line formed on the days there are 2 shows being sold simultaneously. Beginning at 9am we will give out numbers with a time to come back to pick out tickets. People ask us why do I have to come back at a later time? Well the reason is so you don't have to wait for all the people who may have been in front of you on line to pick out their seats. If you prefer not to come back we can choose your seats for you in the order of the numbers that were given out at 9am. When we get to your number we would choose the next best seats according to where your child is on stage or any other preferences you may have. Our time schedule is usually very accurate so if you decide to come back for your tickets at the designated time you will not have to wait long at all, usually 10 minutes is all the time it would take.

The cost of the tickets will be sixteen dollars each. Any profits will be donated to a charity of our choice according to the Department of Education rules. There are allotments on how many tickets you can purchase initially until everyone has had a chance to purchase tickets. The allotment will be five tickets per customer for each show with the exception of show 3 which will be 6 tickets. If you need additional tickets let us know so we can place you on a list for extras. When everyone has had an opportunity to obtain their allotment you will be notified of available tickets. If anyone has an outstanding balance at the time of ticket sales, you may purchase your tickets but we will hold them until all outstanding balances have been paid.

Strollers and Children

Strollers are not permitted in the auditorium, **the aisles must remain clear at all times.**

There is no standing, everyone must have a seat. If you must bring small children they will need a seat. We cannot allow anyone to sit or stand in the aisles.

Wheelchairs

If you need space for a wheelchair for your show, please let us know prior to your ticket sale date so we could make the best arrangements for you

If You Cannot Or Do Not Want To Attend Ticket Sales

If you can't attend ticket sales, you may give the receptionist an envelope with your child's name class, show number, number of tickets, cash for total cost of tickets and any seating preferences you may have. If you do not plan on attending the ticket sales please give the envelope with all the required information a week before your designated ticket sale date. The way we do this is after we complete the sales to the people who did come wait on line we choose the best possible seats remaining according to any preferences you may have.

NOTE: We recommend leaving an envelope for us to choose your seats. PS 58 has a small auditorium and there is good viewing no matter which seats you have.
